

## Award Received

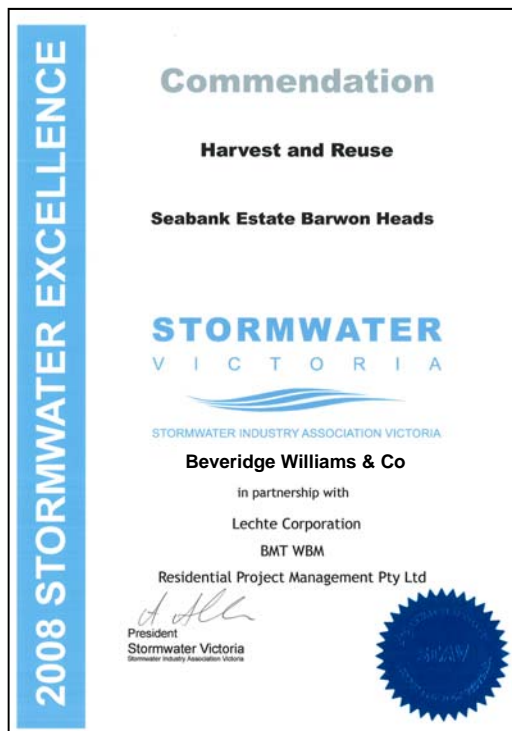

Stormwater Industry Association is the multi-disciplinary advocate for the stormwater industry.

With membership from a wide range of disciplines, SIAV aims to promote the use of innovative and sustainable practices, standards and policies that minimise environmental, social and economic impact.

The awards program recognises Victorian excellence in research, innovation, education and application in the development of best practice for the management of stormwater.

The Stormwater Harvest and Reuse Award recognises projects which demonstrate stormwater harvest and reuse which benefits the general community whilst contributing to the environment and sustainability.



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### Seabank Estate

Located in the coastal town of Barwon Heads, Seabank Estate is a 150 lot residential subdivision.

The 14.7 hectare site has been transformed from a flood prone, windswept paddock into a sustainable living environment.

The site did not have an outfall for drainage. The solution was to use the Open Space for storm water retardation and as a holding area for the water to be pumped down to the Barwon Heads Golf Course, where water is stored in a reservoir and used for irrigating the course.

The excess stormwater is then directed to the Murtnagurht Lagoon, an internationally recognised wetland which is subject to the RAMSAR treaty.
